The Championships will take place at the Canmore Nordic Centre Biathlon Facility September 10 through September 12, 2010.

Range passes must be purchased from the Canmore Nordic Centre before using the range. Range forms requests are available at the below website and must be requested before the day of require use.

IBU Continental Medals will be awarded for the North American Roller Biathlon Championship for Men, Women, Junior Men and Junior Women for the top three finishers in each category. Other categories will be awarded different medals for the event.

Competitors must bring their own roller skis with bindings, ski boots, poles and helmets. Helmets must be unmodified and be by a certified manufacturer and approved by the TD for the event. Helmets are mandatory.

The paved course will be used for roller ski competitors. A running course will be set up as required for the categories registered.

Helmets must be worn whenever athletes are wearing roller skis including the warm-up, zero, and the competition unless the athlete is fully stopped on the firing line.

Rifles will be carried for the roller event.

Standing shooting lanes will have mats for the rollers.

Running biathlon competitions are not part of the North American Championship Event and will not be awarded Continental medals.

Running competitions will be open to: Men, Women, Junior Men, Junior Women,

Youth Men, Youth Women, Senior Boy and Senior Girls and separate medals will be awarded to these competitors. The top three placing will be awarded medals in each category.

Runners will not carry their rifles but will place them in designated racks according to their bib numbers and in accordance with the IBU running specifications. Range procedures will be outlined at the team captain meeting on Thursday night.

All competitors must have a 2010-2011 season membership from their respective divisions or states and will be asked to show proof of membership.
